As you are well aware all the activity is now focused in the Atlantic. There are three separate activities developing.

One being **Hurricane EARL**, now just upgraded to a category 4 hurricane again and, frankly, no one knows where it may make landfall. Hurricane Warnings and Hurricane Watches are all being set on the midAtlantic Coast but Tropical Storm warnings and watches are being set all the way to the Merrimack River in Northern New England. If it continues on the current track we will feel the effects later Friday and Saturday.

The bad news is that it could take a turn left or right over the next 48 hours and be much worse or start to pull away. Keep an eye on the weather reports. We've all said jokingly that the weathermen can't predict more than 48 hours ahead but now we are getting that close.

The second event is **Tropical Storm FIONA**, now just Northeast of San Juan, Puerto Rico is still chugging along and will be something to watch in the

days to come.

The third event is **Tropical Storm Gaston** just getting on it's feet somewhere mid Atlantic half way between Africa and South America. Another subject to keep an eye on.

The media has said that New England hasn't had to deal with a hurricane since **BOB** in 1991 so we probably are forgetting how severe the problems could be in an extreme. Review your plans now and work your plan. We will try to keep you informed with whatever tidbits we hear.
